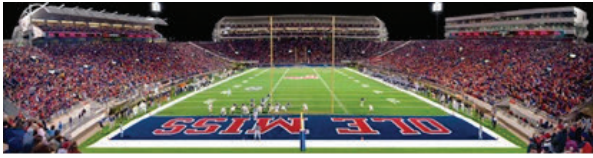

Center for Manufacturing Excellence:

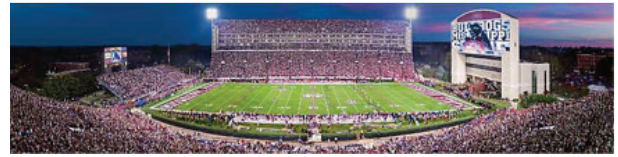
