

Campuses are located in Belden, Guntown, Mooreville, Plantersville, Saltillo, Shannon, Tupelo and Verona. Over 6,000 students are currently enrolled in all programs offered throughout the district. The **Tupelo Public School District (TPSD)** consists of 14 schools, boasting a graduation rate of over 90%. Currently there are over 7,000 students enrolled in all programs. TPSD provides a superior educational path phasing in the new MS College & Career Readiness standards in grades pre-K through 12.
